

Drawing Workshop

Please bring with you the following:

- Pencil (between 2b and 9b)
- Graphite stick (dark, such as 6b)
- Black Indian ink (must be waterproof version)
- Dip pen with drawing nib
- Willow charcoal
- Blu-tak or putty rubber
- Eraser
- A3 or A2 size (sheets or pad) cartridge paper for charcoal drawings, not smooth but with a medium grain (a good weight is 160gsm).
- A4 or A3 size (sheets or pad) good quality watercolour paper for ink and wash drawings. Alternatively, smooth heavyweight white cartridge paper, though this handles water less successfully
- Drawing board - recommended (if your paper is not in a hardback sketchbook that holds its shape)
- Masking tape if using a board
- Water vessel such as jam jar and a few used yogurt pots or similar
- Newspaper and kitchen roll
- Paintbrushes - a selection of flat and pointed, older ones that will become inky (not the hard bristled ones that are used for oils). These need to be suitably sized for the paper size you are using
- Several images/own photos of interesting Mid Wales landscapes (in case of inclement weather)

Optional:

- Coloured pencils or Felt tip pens
- Apron/old shirt to protect clothes
- You may wish to bring a portable easel, a folding picnic table and folding seat
